In addition to the three speakers, more than 35 area organizations representing healthcare, safety and legal services will showcase their products and offerings to attendees in the Lower Level Meeting Rooms of the Municipal Center. Prizes will be raffled.

Walk-in registration begins at 7:30 a.m. on the day of the conference. Attendees are encouraged to arrive early; tickets to the speakers will be given out until capacity in the Council Chambers is reached.

“Part of the mission of Triad is to promote crime prevention for seniors in addition to encouraging involvement in community programs and educational seminars,” Naperville-Lisle Triad chair Brian Foster said. “This conference will empower our seniors in the areas of health, the law and safety so that they can enhance their quality of life to the maximum extent possible.”
